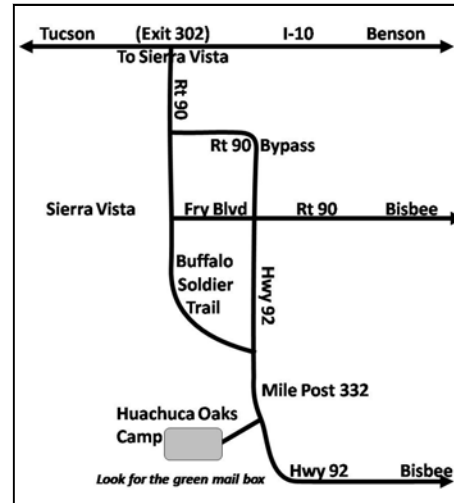
Recreation!

- Explore **Coronado Cave!** Providing you with a short hike, the climb is well worth it.

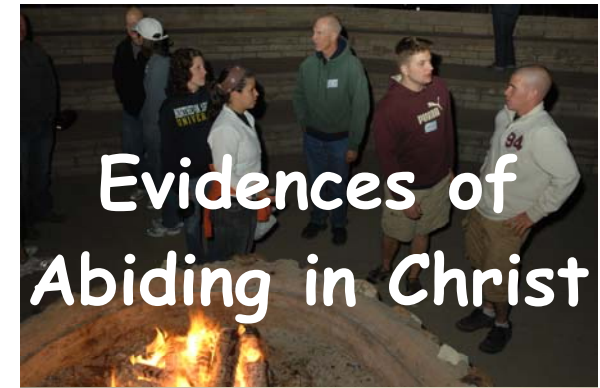
Getting There

Each base is responsible for arranging transportation for their attendees to and from Huachuca Oaks Camp. (Not included in the retreat cost.) Take Exit 302 on I-10 and proceed south on AZ 90 for 27.1 miles. Continue on Garden Ave for 1 mile and then continue on Buffalo Soldier Trail for 6 miles. Turn right on AZ 92 and proceed south for 8.3 miles. Look for the green mail box.
